WHEREAS, He has volunteered his time and energies to Kings Community Action, Hanford Sister City Committee, Kings County Retired Teachers Association, Hanford High School Superintendent's Advisory Committee, and has been a co-founder of the Kings County Commission on Aging and the Kings County Art Commission; and
