Mary Lakritz; social services supervisor

HANFORD — Mary "Mimi" Elizabeth Lakritz, of Hanford, died of a stroke Tuesday at Sacred Heart Hospital. She was 58.

She was born in Milwaukee, and had been a Hanford resident for 31 years. She had worked for Kings County Department of Social Services for 19 years before going to Tulare County Social Services, where she worked nine years as a social services supervisor.

She was a member of the American Association of University Women; the Kings County Art League; and the Kings County Symphony.
